

Figure 2: NDUS Enrollment Rates by ND High School Graduates who enroll in either NDUS or out-of-state colleges following HS graduation




Figure 3: NDUS Enrollment Rates Among College Bound ND High School Graduates with a GPA of 3.9 or Above

As figure 2 shows, a majority of the lower NDUS enrollment rates tend to occur when students possess both a high ACT Composite score *and* a high GPA. Figure 3 below shows the relationship between ACT Composite scores and NDUS enrollment rates in students with a GPA of 3.9 or above.

As figure 3 shows, students with a GPA of 3.9 or above and an ACT Composite of 21 who enroll in either NDUS or out-of-state have enrolled in NDUS at a rate of 86%, with 14% enrolling out-of-state. Students with a GPA of 3.9 or above and an ACT Composite of 33 who enroll in either NDUS or out-of-state have enrolled in NDUS at a rate of 62%, with 38% enrolling out-of-state.
